HOUSE RULES

GENERAL:

House Rules adopted by the Executive Board, intended for the administration of the club, shall be considered **STANDING RULES**. They shall remain in full force and effect, and shall be binding upon successive Executive Boards, unless rescinded or amended.

A copy of these rules will be posted at all times.

DOCKS AND R.V.

1. Boats will dock and R.V.'s parked only with permission of the Port Captain. They will tie up at the Port Captain's direction or that of the Dock Master assigned to the duty.
2. Boats tying up will stern in. With strong winds and/or currents; Dinghies, Houseboats, and boats with single screw may side tie to ensure safety provided dock space available.
3. Scheduled Cruise-In Yacht Clubs, or parade participants, will have first priority for Dock space.
4. Boats may not be washed, painted, or undergo major repairs at the Docks. Fueling is prohibited at the docks due to insurance restrictions.
5. Swimming or fishing is not allowed from docks.
6. Yachts Clubs will be charged \$ 35 per night, \$10 extra for second plug.
7. Members may stay 3 days free, longer stay you will, pay same as above.

CLUBHOUSE

1. Only approved items will be posted on official Bulletin Board. Any Officer/director may approve items of timely interest. Profane, suggestive or discriminatory articles are not allowed.
2. **PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE CLUB HOUSE AT ANY TIME.**
3. Smoking is not allowed in the Club House at any time.
4. Members who wish to purchase a meal without reservations may do so on a "first-come serve first serve" basis, after members with reservations are accommodated.



4 Team Flow Chart Instructions Modified Single Elimination

Each club will draw a card numbered 1 through 4. The Numbers and the Teams will then be recorded on the flow chart below. Games will be played and places will be awarded accordingly;

- Game 1-Played between clubs 1 & 4.
- Game 2-Played between clubs 2 & 3.
- Game 3-Between game 1 & 2 losers. Loser of game 3 takes 4th place.
- Game 4-Between game 1 & 2 winners. Winner of game 4 takes 1st place.
- Game 5-Between game 3 winner & game 4 loser. Winner of game 5 takes 2nd. Loser of game 5 takes 3rd.
